INGREDIENTS

1 cup softened butter

¾ cup brown sugar

½ teaspoon vanilla extract


2 cups all-purpose flour

1½ teaspoons pumpkin pie spice

½ teaspoon salt

½ cup Turbinado sugar

- 2. Heat oven to 350°F. Line two sheet pans with parchment paper. Place Turbinado sugar in a large, shallow bowl.
- 3. Shape dough into 1-inch balls. Roll dough balls in Turbinado sugar and place them 2 inches apart on prepared sheet pans.
- 4. Bake 14-18 minutes or until edges are lightly browned.
- 5. Remove from oven and immediately place a candy pumpkin in the center of each cookie. Press down gently, as far as you can. If cookie cracks when inserting pumpkin, just push it back together and hold in place for 2-3 seconds. Cool completely.

OPTION 1

OPTION 2

OPTION 3

Pre-purchase the items. Hide the items around the house and let the kids find them like an Easter Egg Hunt. Have them check off the items on the list to make sure they have found them all. As a family, deliver the items to a food pantry. Don't forget to pray for the families!
